Students who complete an honors thesis their senior year may substitute the thesis (SPA 490) for one of the collateral requirements.

Students must receive a grade of "C" or better in courses required for the major or minor in the department. If a student receives a grade lower than "C" in a required course, the student must meet with his/her academic adviser to discuss the appropriate action that must be taken to remedy the situation.

Some of the requirements for the major may be met by <u>Study Abroad</u>. Students are strongly encouraged to spend at least one semester abroad. All majors must take at least one Spanish course per semester in the senior year.

<u>Honors Program in Spanish</u>: A student who has a 3.25 cumulative average and a 3.5 average in the major may be invited to become a candidate for the Honors Program in Spanish.

*To be eligible for SPA 490 Independent Research and Study, a student must be a junior or a senior in good academic standing. Each proposal must be approved by a faculty sponsor, the department chairperson, the department committee, and the Dean of the College of Liberal Arts, Education and Sciences.
