Students who complete an honors thesis their senior year may substitute the thesis (SPA 490) for one of the collateral requirements.

Students must receive a grade of "C" or better in courses required for the major or minor in the department. If a student receives a grade lower than "C" in a required course, the student must meet with his/her academic adviser to discuss the appropriate action that must be taken to remedy the situation.

Some of the requirements for the major may be met by Study Abroad. Students are strongly encouraged to spend at least one semester abroad. All majors must take at least one Spanish course per semester in the senior year.

Honors Program in Spanish: A student who has a 3.25 cumulative average and a 3.5 average in the major may be invited to become a candidate for the Honors Program in Spanish.

*To be eligible for SPA 490 Independent Research and Study, a student must be a junior or a senior in good academic standing. Each proposal must be approved by a faculty sponsor, the department chairperson, the department committee, and the Dean of the College of Liberal Arts, Education and Sciences.
